## **S.T.A.R.S Mentor Description**

### Mentor's Role

- A mentor is a caring and responsible adult who takes time to be a friend to a young person.
- A mentor listens, supports, and guides a young person on a consistent basis over a specified period of time.
- Mentors are volunteers in your community who know that young people can make a positive difference in the world if given the chance.

### Duties & Responsibilities

- Be at least 21 years of age.
- Be willing to adhere to all S.T.A.R.S Mentoring Program policies and procedures.
- Be willing to communicate with the mentee weekly.
- Complete the screening process.
- Agree to attend mentor trainings as required.
- Be willing to communicate regularly with the Program Coordinator and submit monthly meeting and activity information.

### Time Commitments

- Agree to at least one school year commitment to the program.
- Commit to spending a minimum of 30 minutes a week with the mentee.

### Benefits to mentors

- Personal fulfillment through contribution to community and individual
- Satisfaction in helping someone mature, progress, and achieve goals
- Training sessions and group activities and ongoing support
- Participation in a mentor support group
- Mileage and expenses are tax deductible
- Mentee/mentor group activities, participant recognition events
